If you are under age 70 ½ and are entitled to receive or are receiving a Retirement Benefit and you remain in or return to employment in the same industry, in the same trade or craft and in the same geographic area, you will forfeit one monthly pension payment for each calendar month during which you are employed 40 or more hours. Upon ceasing such employment and notifying the Administrator, your Retirement Benefit will either commence or resume in the amount you would have been receiving had you not remained in or returned to employment. If you work more than 250 hours in a Plan Year, your benefit will be recalculated.
